

## **TOTEM POLES AROUND THE HAINES AREA**

### **ALASKA INDIAN ARTS - 24 FORT SEWARD DRIVE**

Local museum that welcomes visitors to view artists in action.

### **1 MILE WELCOME SIGN - 1 MILE HAINES HIGHWAY**

On display is a 12' Raven Pole and a 12' Eagle Pole, each adding the representation of other clans.

### **CHILKAT CENTER - TOWER ROAD**

On display outside is a 37' Raven Pole representing the guarding of the clans and inside a 7' Raven Pole.

### **CHILKAT VALLEY ARTS - 209 WILLARD STREET**

On display is a 16' pole representing the Folletti Family Clan.

### **HAINES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL - MAIN STREET**

On display is a 40' Friendship Pole representing both the Eagle and Raven Clan.

### **HAINES FIREHALL - .5 MILE HAINES HIGHWAY**

On display is a Killer Whale.

### **HEINMILLER'S RESIDENCE - 26 FORT SEWARD DRIVE**

On display is a 12' pole representing the legend of Jonico & the Koostaka.

### **LOOKOUT PARK - FRONT STREET**

On display is a 16' pole representing an Eagle Family Clan.

### **SHELDON MUSEUM - 10 FIRST AVENUE SOUTH**

On display is the original smaller version of the Friendship Pole.

### **SPARK'S RESIDENCE - 524 MAIN STREET**

On display is a 10' Raven Pole.

### **TRIBAL HOUSE - FORT SEWARD PARADE GROUNDS**

On display outside, the corners are 4 poles representing a blending of clans, two of these poles traveled to Expo 70'. Also on the outside to the left is a 30' Raven Pole and on the backside is a 35' Friendship Pole. Inside the tribal house are a Beaver Pole, Raven/Whale Pole, Raven Pole and Raven/Frog Pole.
